SCENE 1

While the audience fills the room, we see tech crew and actors running around in a panic.

As the house lights turn off, Alex (dressed as a Texan plumber) and Simone step forward.

SIMONE: Hello everyone! Good evening-

ALEX: Hello-

IMSONE: I'm Simone, I'm Dissasubjugated Theatre's artistic

director.

ALEX: Alex, associate artistic director.

SIMONE: Thank you so much for being here today-

ALEX: Yeah, yeah-

SIMONE: We are eternally grateful for your support-

ALEX: SO grateful-

SIMONE: Really grateful-

ALEX: Honestly!

SIMONE: We'd be nowhere without you-

ALEX: Yeah really-

SIMONE: So, you might be wondering-

ALEX: Truly nowhere-

SIMONE: Right-

ALEX: We'd still be doing community theatre in a church somewhere-

SIMONE: Haha, ha.

ALEX: And at least with a church we'd have more-

SIMONE: Anyway.

ALEX: Yes, yes, anyway.

SIMONE: Thank you for being here-

ALEX: Sorry.

SIMONE: -for our new project, The Secret Garden!

ALEX: Yessir!

SIMONE: You might be wondering what play you're about to see!

ALEX: Hell yeah!

SIMONE: Big secret!

ALEX: I'm wondering!

SIMONE: That's what we created The Secret Garden for!

ALEX: I'm kidding, I know what play we're doing.
